THINKING LOCALLY
FINE WINES FROM JUST UP THE ROAD

HERMANN J. WIEMER

While the history of wine in America is generally and for the most part localized in the sun and fog of California's Napa and Sonoma counties, recent years have brought to the foreground a number of other top quality wine regions around the country. None should ever shadow New York's Finger Lakes Region and particularly this idyllic property nestled on a rising mound of earth and peering down at Seneca Lake just near Dundee, NY.

Hermann J. Wiemer was born in Bernkastel, Mosel, Germany - merely the uttering of that town's name is likely to bring on an easily measurable Pavlovian response in fans of the hallowed (if oft misunderstood) Riesling. Hermann's family, with nearly 300 years of winemaking and vinegrowing history, boasted an unrivaled if unglamorous reputation as skilled agricultural laborers and unparalleled experts in growing vines in the most hallowed vineyards of the Mosel (Dr. Thanisch's legendary vineyards, widely regarded to be the best Riesling sites in the world). Hermann even as a boy was instrumental in his family's trade, learning firsthand from his father and developing a preternatural ability to cultivate vines and (after the onslaught of phylloxera) an unmatched hand at grafting *vinifera* scions to American rootstocks.

And so it was with this unique background that Hermann arrived in the Finger Lakes in the 1960's where alone he saw in the gravelly soils and proximity to Seneca Lake's sun reflecting face the same combination of factors that made such fine wine in the vineyards of his youth, and so he purchased an 80 acre plot of land and, after countless trials aimed at finding the perfect combination of *vinifera* clones and American rootstock for that parcel, planted the property with Riesling and Chardonnay, and with that the Finger Lakes, as a wine region capable of producing world class *vinifera* based wine, was born.

Now, nearly 50 years later, the Finger Lakes have emerged on the national wine stage and should be poised to do the same globally, with wineries like Hermann J. Wiemer leading the region and making unquestionably world class Riesling that no doubt harkens back to its roots in the austere and craggy hills of the Mosel Valley but that also, like all European immigrants and their cultures has now become something wholly New York and wholly American.

Today the winery is run by Hermann's long-time apprentice, winemaker Fred Merwarth, and by Swedish wine business maven Oskar Bynke. Both are dear friends of the restaurant, and we are proud both of the close bonds we share with so commendable a local partner and of the great future that I'm certain awaits them at Hermann J. Wiemer winery.

Dry

The dry wines from Hermann J. Wiemer are bright and linear with dazzling Riesling acidity and structure, precise and pronounced minerality, and focused and electric personalities. Similar to the kabinetts of Mosel, these are zippy, racy wines with laserbeam like intensity and finely honed, well-defined structure.

Off-Dry

The off dry rieslings, harkening back to the great spätlese wines of Riesling’s German origins, and complex, round, richer and fuller riesling than the racier dry wines. In many ways these are more brooding, more contemplative. Robust white peach and bright acidity with impeccable structure,

Late Harvest

The most fabled and indeed most precious styles of riesling are undoubtedly the sweet, late harvest beerenauslese and trockenbeerenauslese wines of Germany’s mythical Rheingau, Mosel, Pfalz, et. al. Capable of living in some cases for a century, these botrytis infected grapes are hand selected, even one at a time, to make some of the finest, most complex, wine on the planet. The Wiemer late harvest wines are no different, being undeniably satisfying to both the palate and the oenophilic cerebral cortex.

OUR CHANCE TO SPOTLIGHT WINES OF GREAT INTEREST

DOMAINE FOURRIER

It is no secret that Burgundy produces many of the world's greatest and most expensive wines. The names of famous producers and winemakers are often uttered in hushed and hallowed tones as if whispering incantations that might somehow bring this pantheon of personalities somehow nearer and simpler to grasp. Perhaps you too unconsciously conjure up goosebumps when hearing the names of Mayer, Leroy, Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, and so on... but you may, perhaps, not yet feel so intense a euphoric shiver when you hear uttered the name Domaine Fourrier... and we think that's a shame.

The estate now called Domaine Fourrier was born Domaine Pernot-Fourrier when founded during the late 1930s by Fernand Pernot, uncle to Jean-Claude Fourrier who would later join Mr. Pernot in managing the domaine in 1969. The winery, plagued by inconsistency of quality and unfocused management, meandered, more or less, through the 1970s and 1980s, ultimately shrinking into relative obscurity and disappearing from import.

Then, in 1994, Jean-Marie Fourrier, the domaine's prodigal son, returned to his home estate after stints with famed Henri Mayer and Domaine Drouhin (in Oregon). The immediate result was a dramatic improvement in quality and a return to traditional winemaking, putting Domaine Fourrier instantly back on the Burgundy map.

Since that time, Jean-Marie has continued only to improve the quality of the vineyards and wines and now should be counted as one of the top winemakers and vigneron in all of France. The Fourrier wines are blessed with elegance and suppleness, even when bold and powerful (see "Clos St. Jacques"). Jean-Marie makes wine only from the fruit of vines of at least 30 years in age, and most of his vines are between 50 and 70 years old. Vineyard practice eschews genetically modified or selected clones, preserving only the original vineyard material during replanting. Selection in the vineyards is often austere leading to impeccable wines in fine vintages and stunningly impressive wines from vintages lesser producers might deem unacceptable.

Domaine Fourrier's wines are as vivid an expression of the French notion of *terroir* as exists in all of Burgundy. We at the Lambs Club are proud to offer a fine selection of multiple *terroirs*, and *climats* from some recent, fine Burgundian vintages.

Bourgogne Blanc

Jean-Marie Fourrier crafts a Bourgogne Blanc that is both an extreme rarity to consumer (because there just is not that much to go around) and an incredible value. Produced from parcels of Chardonnay in the northern Côte de Nuits, an unusual place not to find Pinot Noir growing in Burgundy, the Fourrier Bourgogne Blanc is broad, lush, underlined with a beautiful linearity and acidity, and delicious to consume.

Gevrey-Chambertin

The Domaine Fourrier wines are arguably at their best when coming from this idyllic village in northern Burgundy. Exploring the diverse *terroir* you're likely to discover a dazzling range of styles showcasing suppleness and elegance but also power and boldness. The delicate "Aux Echezeaux," for example, is soft and supple and floral while the "Griotte-Chambertin" packs quite a punch.

Morey-St.-Denis

One of the Domaine's tiniest parcels, this is a rare gem to be able to taste. Nestled just under the "Clos Baulet" 1er Cru vineyard, this parcel gives wines of lush fruit with classic minerality and an interesting expression of Burgundy and of Pinot Noir. It is particularly revealing when tasting against the domaine's offerings from other villages, perhaps casting some light on the wonderful minutia that set them apart from one another.

Chambolle-Musigny

The village of Chambolle provides Jean-Marie with another opportunity to highlight the varying and enticing personalities of these differing villages and *terroirs*. Planted in 1928, the "Gruenchers" vineyard produced potent, concentrated pinot noir with Fourrier's trademark elegance and finesse.

KEN WRIGHT

Ken Wright's career in the wine business started out much like mine... while a student, Ken Wright began waiting tables, a part-time vocation that for obvious reasons often puts young adults in a veritable hot zone for catching the oh so contagious wine bug. So grave was Mr. Wright's case that he had no choice but to move to California and study viticulture and enology at UC-Davis, America's pre-eminent wine science academy.

Like many careers, Ken Wright's began to gather momentum near his Alma Mater, finding credible early experience working with exceptional Monterrey producers Ventana and Talbott, but it wasn't until his move to McMinnville Oregon in the heart of Willamette Valley that things really started to take off.

Here Mr. Wright started Panther Creek Cellars and then Ken Wright Cellars in turn, firmly establishing himself as one of the premier producers of note in arguably America's best zone for Pinot Noir (he also makes one Chardonnay and two Pinot Blancs under the Ken Wright Cellars label).

But for the purposes of this forum it is not enough for us that he be simply a fine producer from a demonstrated quality region. It seems Mr. Wright as well remained unsatisfied being only so simply distinguished. It is Ken Wright's tireless determination to exposing each of the varied styles of wine that emerge from the varied subregions, vineyards and terroirs of the Willamette Valley as a whole that sets him apart from other producers, and in his hands the region's personality seems not static and easily generalized but dynamic, vividly elaborate and composed of infinite permutations each as pleasant as the next.

Mr. Wright accomplishes this by producing a dizzying array of single vineyard Pinot Noir based wines from multiple AVAs (American Viticultural Areas, or officially recognized regions) within the Willamette Valley. We at the Lambs Club are elated to offer a wide selection from Ken Wright's bright and exciting 2010 vintage, covering 5 of these definitive and unique AVAs and 10 unique vineyards.
